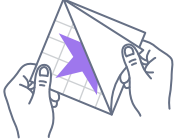


How to Apply Transfer Decals

Transfer decals use a clear tape to hold your design together during installation.
After the decal is applied, the transfer tape is removed.

- **Clean the Surface**
Use rubbing alcohol or soap and water, then dry completely.
Avoid glass cleaners. They can prevent adhesion.
- **Prepare the Sticker**
Firmly rub across the transfer tape with a squeegee or credit card.
This helps the design stick to the transfer tape.
- **Remove the Backing**
Slowly peel the paper backing away at an angle.
If the design stays on the paper, replace the backing and repeat Step 2.
- **Apply the Sticker**
Position the sticker, then firmly rub over the transfer tape with a squeegee or credit card.
Wait 24 hours before removing the transfer tape.
- **Remove the Transfer Tape**
Peel the transfer tape away slowly at an angle.
If any part of the design lifts, press it back down and repeat Step 4.

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
